Our Voting Day Adventure

Walk through this map with your
child(ren) before you vote in person.

1



1. Pick a Day

We choose a day to go – some places let you vote early; others only on Election Day.

2



2. Find Our Place

Grown-ups look up exactly where our designated voting location is, so we know just where to go.

3. Go Inside

Walk in or enter together and say hello to the friendly election workers.

4



4. Check In

Parent or caregiver tells the worker their name and gives them their voter information so they can find them on the big voter list.

5



5. Get a Ballot

Parent or caregiver is handed a paper (or a screen) called a ballot to vote.

6



6. Fill out ballot

In a private booth, parent or caregiver marks their choices. It's a secret – even from us!

7. Cast Vote

The ballot goes into a box or machine to get counted!
